Peace Declarations from Scripture

Peace of Christ: Christ has left me his peace. His peace he has given to me and not the peace that the world gives. Thus, I do not let my heart be troubled, or let it be fearful. John 14:26

Overcoming Peace: Through my union with Christ I have peace through the things that He has spoken to me. In the world I will encounter oppression; but I take courage because Christ has overcome the world. John 16:33

Peace that Rules: I let the peace of God rule in my heart, since I was called in one body to peace with thankfulness. Colossians 3:15

No Stumbling: I have great peace because I love God's law. Nothing causes me to stumble. Psalm 119:165

Perfect Peace: You will keep me in perfect peace, because my mind is fixed on you; because I place my confidence in you. Isaiah 26:23

Guarded by Peace: Because I override anxiety by taking every issue and request to God through prayer and petition with thanksgiving; therefore, the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, guards my heart and my mind through Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7

Peace Like a River: You are the Lord my Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel: The Lord my God, who teaches me to profit, who leads me by the way that I should go. Because I have followed to your commands, I have peace like a river, and righteousness as the waves of the sea. Isaiah 58:7-8

Sleep in Peace: In peace I will lay myself down and sleep, for you, Lord alone, make me live in safety. Psalm 4:8
